





Call for Erasmus+ KA171 Staff Mobility 2023/2024

at the Universidad de León (Spain)

Within the framework of the Erasmus+ program (Key Action 171) the Universidad de León has been the beneficiary of a grant destined to finance mobility stays during the 2023/2024 academic year. Under the 2023-1-ES01-KA171-HED-000138797 project and in partnership with the Université de Kikwit (Democratic Republic of the Congo), the Vice Rectorate for Internationalisation of the Universidad de León offers 1 grant for staff mobilities at the Universidad de León.

Requirements

- Applicants must be faculty members at Université de Kikwit.
- Applicants will have to fill in a Mobility Agreement.
- Beneficiaries will need to take an accident and emergency insurance that covers the duration of their mobility including the travel days. We recommend the Oncampus insurance for their extensive coverage: https://oncampus.es/sequros/oncampus-pdipas/
- Every mobility should have the possibility of academic recognition.
- Mobility must be completed before end of July 2024.

Financial support

Each grant will be financed as follows:

- Individual support: 160 € per day (5 days of activity + 2 days of travel = 1.120€)
- Travel expenses: 820 €.

Time

The period of stay comprises 5 activity days and 2 days of travel. An activity day cannot coincide with a travel day

Applications

Staff Members who are interested in this first Call of applications for a mobility stay have to send they applications to the International Relations Office of the University of Kikwit, Office of the Rector. Following documents are required:

- Letter in English
- CV
- Recommendation of the Dean of the home Faculty
- Proof of employment at the university of Kikwit
- Passport (valid for more than 6 months)

Application deadline

Applications included all required documents must be sent before 30th of November 2023.







Valorisation scale and selection criteria

In order to be selected, the applicant must reach for each following criteria at least 7/10:

- University work experience
- Impact of the research/training project after the mobility stay
- Moral integrity
- Language skills
- Intercultural skills

Call for Erasmus+ KA171 Student Mobility for Study 2023/2024

at the Universidad de León (Spain)

Within the framework of the Erasmus+ program (Key Action 171) the Universidad de León has been the beneficiary of a grant destined to finance mobility stays during the 2023/2024 academic year. Under the 2023-1-ES01-KA171-HED-000138797 project and in partnership with the Université de Kikwit (Democratic Republic of the Congo), the Vice Rectorate for Internationalisation of the Universidad de León offers **1** grant for students from Université de Kikwit to study at the Universidad de León.

Requirements

- Applicants must be official degree or doctorate students at Université de Kikwit (only 1st or 3rd cycle, not 2nd cycle/master level).
- Applicants must be at least in their second year of higher education studies.
- High motivation and excellent academic performance are required.
- Students that have been beneficiaries of an Erasmus+ grant previously must not exceed the 12-month scholarship period limit for undergraduate studies.
- Knowledge of Spanish / English at level B1 is essential.
- Mobility must be completed before end of July 2024.
- Beneficiaries will need to take an accident and emergency insurance that covers the duration of their mobility, we recommend the Oncampus insurance for their extensive coverage: https://oncampus.es/en/seguros/oncampus-estudia/
- Every mobility should have the possibility of academic recognition.

Financial support

Each grant will be financed as follows:

- Individual support: 850 € per month (up to a maximum of 5 months)
- Travel expenses: 820 €.

In addition, there is an additional grant of €250 per month for the selected beneficiary if he/she is considered a student with fewer opportunities (provided that the home university communicates this at the time of nomination).

Time

The period of stay comprises a minimum of 3 months and up to a maximum of 5 months.

Applications

Degree or doctorate students of the university of Kikwit who are interested in this Call of applications for a mobility stay have to send they applications to the International Relations Office of the University of Kikwit, Office of the Rector. Following documents are required:

- Letter & CV in English
- Recommendation of the Dean of the home Faculty
- Enrolment certificate
- Transcript of Records
- Passport (valid for more than 6 months)







Application deadline

Applications included all required documents must be sent before the 30th of November 2023.
